
Parade

We filled a barrel with food (130 pounds!) for Gleaners and Food Bank, and two pies were auctioned off at \$100 each in support of our service work.





It's that time again... Back to School!

PCS conducted a very short drive for school supplies in mid-August. Bins were set up at Peace Lutheran Church, College United Methodist Church, Philomath Fire Station 201, and the 53rd Street Bi-Mart in Corvallis. Over 450 pounds of school supplies were delivered to area schools.

Over half of the donations were presented

sponsored her fifth annual drive for school supplies in the Philomath area. Fifty-five "School is Cool" thermal bags filled with school supplies were collected and donated to help students get a good start to the school year.

Massive Donation of Socks and Underwear

PageWide WebPress, an organizational/business unit of Hewlett-Packard (HP), conducted a donation drive of socks and underwear for JKK, under the management of Holly Bendixen. A total of 1369 pairs of socks and underwear, from toddlers to teens were collected and donated to JKK.

In the meantime, a pilot project called Foundations for Success was started through JKK, providing a new package of socks and underwear for school-aged children registered with JKK. This project was designed to help offset the cost of Back-to-School clothing for local children.

Thanks so much to the citizens of Philomath and Benton County as a whole for supporting the efforts of our programs at PCS. Hundreds of people will benefit from the services we provide in our five programs: Philomath Community Gleaners, Philomath Food Bank, June's Kids Kloset, Lupe's Community Garden and Holiday Cheer.
