
#### 2021 Annual Report

The PCS Annual Report is now available online <u>via this link</u>. It is so encouraging to see what can be done when folks come together under our motto of *people helping people*. Here are a few report highlights:

- ★ We logged **15,834 hours** from over **100 volunteers**! What a generous community we have.
- ★ Through our five programs, PCS provided social services to over **2,250 adults** and **1,250 children**.
- ★ We processed over 600,000 lbs (300 tons!) of food and over 4,000 lbs of childrens' clothing.


## **Call for Volunteers!**
